NOVEMBER 2025 – Digital Awareness Session (Video-Based Learning) – In November, a Digital Voter Awareness Session was organized to help students understand the voting process using modern digital tools.

Highlights: – Screening of Election Commission educational videos Digital presentations on the step-by-step voting procedure Awareness on the importance of secure, independent voting Interactive Q&A session to clear doubts Students created short digital posters/messages on "Responsible Voting"
